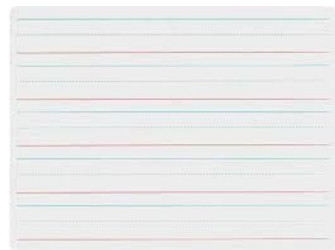

VOCABULARY

technology

DEFINITION

Machines we use that make our lives easier.

EXAMPLE

A computer is an example of **technology** we use to help us get more work done.



ASK

What technology do we have in our classroom?

VOCABULARY

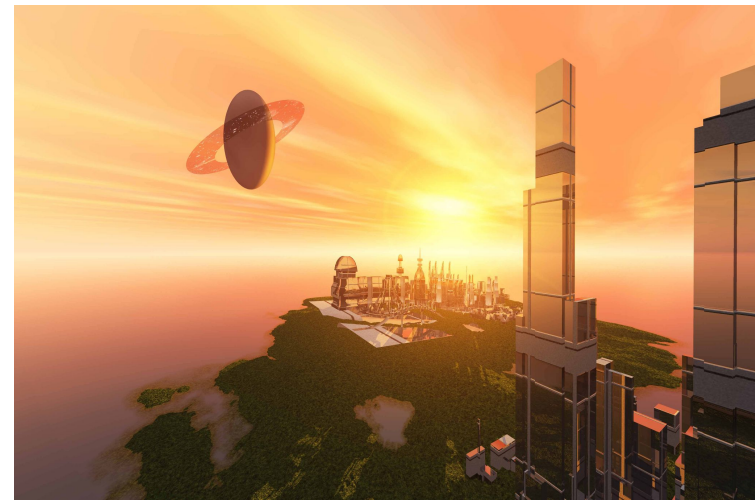
future

DEFINITION

A period of time that has not happened yet

EXAMPLE

In the **future**, we may all be able to travel to space like astronauts do.



ASK

What is something you want to do in the **future**?

VOCABULARY

vanished

DEFINITION

To quickly disappear from sight. **Vanished** is the past tense of **vanish**.

EXAMPLE

The bridge **vanished** in the fog.



ASK

What is something that has **vanished** right in front of your eyes?

VOCABULARY

outer space

DEFINITION

The area beyond Earth's atmosphere, where the stars and planets are.

EXAMPLE

I use a telescope at night to look at **outer space**.



ASK

If you could take a trip to **outer space**, what would you want to go see?

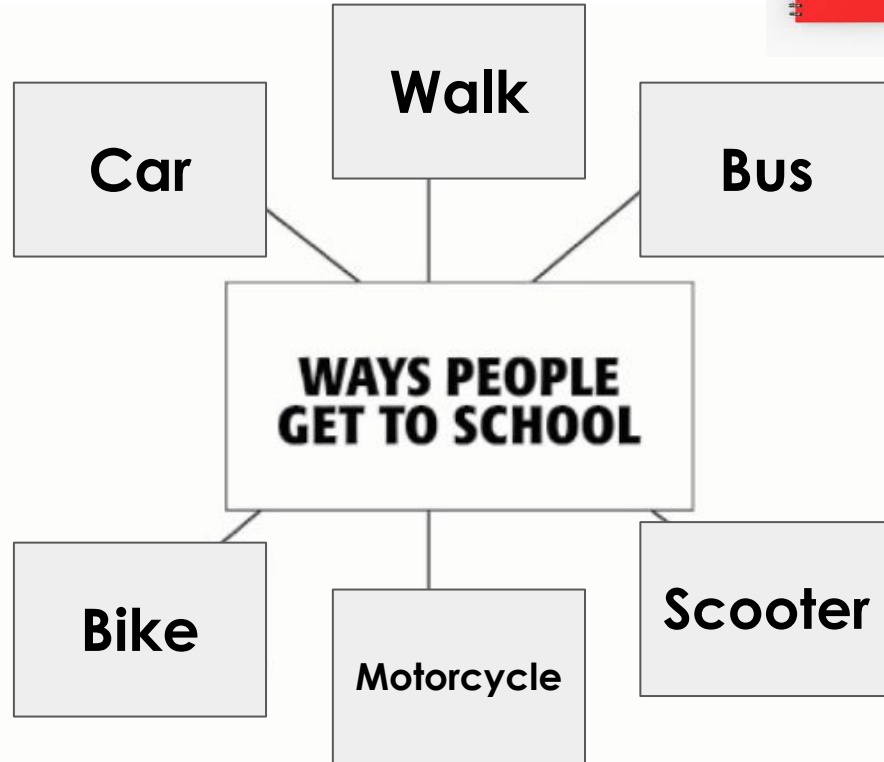
